




## Ask the right question





"What is next step that would move the situation to the better?"





## How? Here is one way.

1. Pick the most painful problem
2. Track root cause / 5 "why"
3. Problem solve
4. Get management attention to root causes outside team
4. Assign responsible persons (incl. managers)
5. Review actual results
